is Professor of Applied Mathematics, specializing in statistics at Toulouse School of Economics, France. Her areas of research include multivariate data analysis, survey sampling theory and, to a less extent, spatial econometrics and statistics. She has published more than eighty articles in refereed journals and books and is an associate editor of Journal of Multivariate Analysis, Computational Statistics and Data Analysis - Statistical Data Science and Statistical Papers. She has been a member of the scientific and organizing committees of several conferences. Since 2015, she has been Director of the Master 2 in Statistics and Econometrics at TSE, offering both initial and continuing training. She was an elected member of the Board of Directors of IASC-ERS (International Association of Statistical Computing, European Regional Section) between 2018 and 2022. She was the vice-president (2011-2014) and the president (2014-2015) of the European Course on Advanced Statistics. She is an elected member of the International Statistical Institute since 2017.
